Class of 2030 Timeline

Congressman Josh Riley strongly encourages students to begin their applications to our nation's service academies between their junior and senior years of high school.

The application process involves students requesting a nomination from one of the available nominating offices and submitting an application for admission to the service academy(s) of choice.

Summer 2025: Establish Candidacy with Service Academies

Start your candidacy with the service academy or academies of your choice. You can begin this process as early as May 1st, and it's best to do so as soon as possible if you haven't already.

The service academies include:

- U.S. Naval Academy
- U.S. Military Academy
- U.S. Merchant Marine Academy
- U.S. Air Force Academy
- <u>U.S. Coast Guard Academy</u> (does not require a Service Academy nomination)

June 1, 2025: Congressman Riley Begins Accepting Applications for the Class of 2030

Congressman Riley will begin accepting completed applications on June 1, 2025.

Because of the competitive nature of the nomination process, it's highly recommended that you apply to all relevant nominating authorities for which you are eligible. These authorities include the President, Vice-President, your U.S. Senators, the Secretaries of the Navy, Army, and Air Force, as well as the superintendents of your selected academies. If you receive a nomination from another source, please notify Congressman Riley's office immediately.

Important Reminder: In addition to submitting your nomination application to the District Office, don't forget to complete and submit the admissions application for the academy or academies of your choice.

Required Documents to Complete Your Application:

- A completed Service Academy Nomination Application
- Resume

- Official transcripts from all high schools, colleges, or preparatory schools attended
- Personal Statement "Why do you want to attend a U.S. Service Academy?"
- SAT or ACT scores
- Three letters of recommendation

October 15, 2025: Deadline for Nomination Application Submission

Be sure to submit your completed application materials by October 15, 2025. After submission, Congressman Riley's Service Academy Selection Board will review applications and will reach out to schedule interviews with a select group of candidates. We recommend confirming that your application has been received.

November 2025: Interview with Congressman Riley's Service Academy Selection Board

Interviews will take place in November at a location to be announced. This is the final step in the nomination process.

December 1, 2025: Nomination Status Notification

Applicants for Congressman Riley's Service Academy Nomination will be notified of their nomination status no later than December 1st, 2025.

Spring 2026: Academies Notify Applicants of Appointment

Most academies will notify applicants of their official status by mid-April 2026.

Important Notes:

- If you decide not to pursue a nomination to a Service Academy, please let our office know so we can close your file.
- If you receive a nomination from Congressman Riley but later choose to withdraw your application, kindly notify our office as soon as possible.

Please complete all responses and submit your completed application packet as a .pdf file by email to **NY19.AcademyNominations@mail.house.gov** or hand deliver it to Congressman Josh Riley's Binghamton office by **October 15th, 2025, at 5:00 PM**. **Late applications will not be accepted.**

To ensure your application is considered, it is crucial to follow the process outlined below. Failure to adhere to these instructions may result in your materials not being considered. For email submissions, please send everything in **ONE email** to **NY19.AcademyNominations@mail.house.gov**. Alternatively, you may hand deliver your packet to Congressman Josh Riley's Bingahtmon office. **Please do not mail your materials, as mail can be easily lost or delayed.** If you are submitting via email, you must name the documents and title your email as follows: "J_Lastname_Application" with the first letter being your first initial.

Minimum Requirements for US Service Academies

Below are the minimum requirements for all U.S. Service Academies that require a nomination from a Member of Congress. Please note that meeting these requirements makes applicants eligible to attend a U.S. Service Academy, but it does not guarantee a Congressional Nomination or admission.

Academy	Minimum Requirements
U.S. Naval Academy	 U.S. Citizen At least 17 years of age and must not have passed 23rd birthday on 1 July of the year of entry Unmarried/No Dependents Nomination Required CFA and DODMERB exams
U.S. Air Force Academy	 U.S. Citizen Be at least 17 but not past your 23rd birthday by July 1 of the year you enter the Academy. Unmarried/No Dependents Nomination Required CFA and DODMERB exams
U.S. Military Academy	 U.S. Citizen Be at least 17 but not past your 22nd birthday by July 1 of the year you enter the Academy Unmarried/No Dependents Nomination Required CFA and DODMERB exams
U.S. Merchant Marine Academy	 U.S. Citizen Be at least 17 but not past your 25th birthday by July 1 of the year you enter the Academy Nomination Required CFA and DODMERB exams

- Specific act(s) that you feel have prepared you for the rigorous challenges of attending a U.S. Service Academy
- Motivator(s) (i.e., family members and/or a specific event) that generated your interest with U.S. Service Academies

Application Agreement

Thoroughly read the following before signing. Your signature indicates your agreement with the following statements. Your application will not be considered if not signed.

The information on this application and included in my packet is all true and correct to the best of my knowledge. It is my sincere desire to attend a U.S. Service Academy, and I fully intend to accept an appointment, if offered. I am a U.S. Citizen, or will be by July 1, 2025. I am or will be at least 17, but not yet 23 years of age (USMMA: 25 years of age) on July 1, 2025. I amunmarried, and do not have any dependents. I am a legal resident of the 19th Congressional District of New York. (Exception granted for USMMA nomination.)

I request that Congressman Josh Riley consider my application for a congressional nomination to the U.S. Service Academy or Academies I have indicated. I understand that by placing a rank number for any U.S. Service Academy on page 5, binds me to complete the entirety of that U.S. Service Academy's application for admission. This means if I do not complete the entire application to all ranked academies by January 31th, 2026, I will not be eligible for a nomination from Congressman Josh Riley. I authorize Congressman Riley to monitor my progress in seeking an appointment to an Academy, and hereby consent for the Academy to divulge information from my records for this purpose.

I waive the provisions of the Privacy Act of 1974 to allow the sharing of information with the Service Academies and their representatives, as well as members of Congressman Josh Riley's staff and the 19th District Service Academy Selection Board. I hereby authorize these parties to disclose, discuss, inspect, and copy any information regarding my application and information provided. I also authorize and release any third parties to discuss/disclose any information to verify my prior employment, activities, or criminal history.

I have read this entire application and all required material included. I understand I must submit my signed and completed application by the 5:00 PM, October 31, 2025 deadline. If not submitted by this time, I understand that my application will not be considered.

In the event I receive a nomination, I authorize Congressman Riley's office to release this information to the news media and public. Likewise, in the event I receive and accept an offer of appointment, I authorize Congressman Riley's office to release this information to the news media and public.

It is my sincere desire to attend a U.S. Service Academy. I understand that by attending a service academy I will be required to fulfill an obligation of five years of military service following graduation. I fully commit to this requirement and responsibility.
